## Ozello Trail



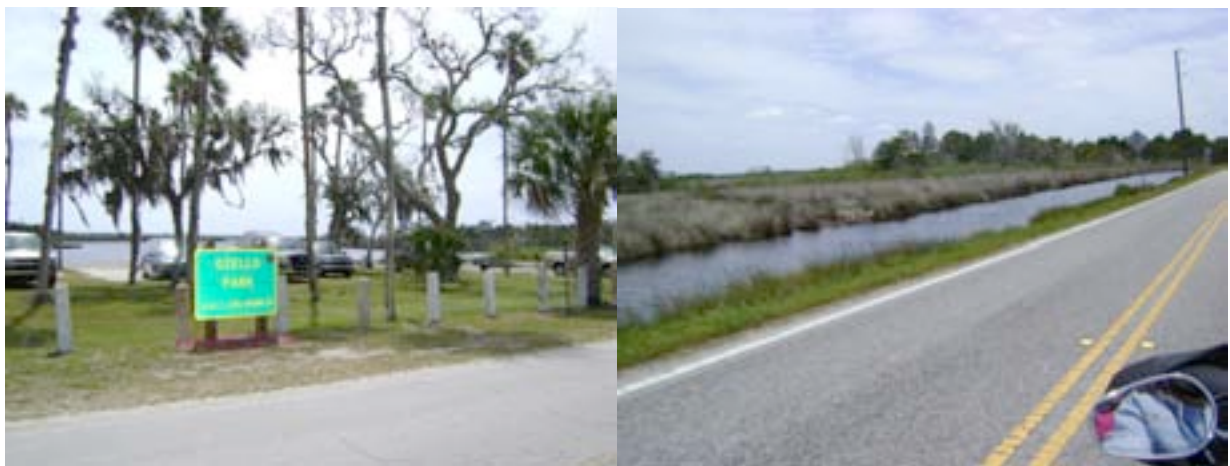
US 19 south to 494 West, 2 miles South  
of Crystal River Airport.

This ride covers 9.47 miles and has 91 curves, our very own "Tale of the Dragon" that any type rider will really enjoy.



The Ozello Trail starts slow but gets interesting very quick. While crossing several small bridges pause and look for wildlife, including playful otters alongside the road in the waters. A gator, wild hog or snake might appear so keep your eyes alert.

2045 S John Brown Dr. is Ozello Park. Take the time to launch a boat or kayak or canoe. Explore the beautiful area.



South Estuary Drive takes you way back to "Old Florida" but with lots of new homes. Wander along Bear Creek Lane and Waterbend Pt. for more "Old Florida" scenery.



Back out on Ozello Trail continue west to The Old Port Cove for some of the best seafood you will ever eat. My favorite is always the Clam Chowder and Almond Grouper. Eating inside or outside the service is always great. A major meeting, greeting and eating place for motorcycle riders from all over the State of Florida.



After eating take your time and walk along the water's edge, along the causeway across the water and just enjoy. Make the time right and you can take in a beautiful sunset.



Complete the west bound ride with a stop at the very end of the trail, take a right and stop at the boat launch in Ozello Community Park (410 N Pirate Pt) for more pictures.





After enjoying the relaxing view you get to enjoy the 9.47 mile ride back in to US19, Hopefully this will be after the sunsets so you get to see a different part of the wildlife.

Remember, not too fast, just sit back and enjoy.
